

# Storm Drain Awareness



Here are 5 easy steps you can take to help protect our watersheds:

1. **Rainbows in the sky, not on our roads!** Maintain your car free from oil and fluid leaks. Avoid washing your car in the street.
2. **When it rains, it drains!** Properly disposing of your trash, debris, and rubbish so it does not drain into the storm system.
3. **Stop POO-llution!** Keep the street clean by picking up your pet's waste and discarding of it properly in the trash can.
4. **Think twice about pesticides!** Do not apply pesticides or other chemicals near storm drains or when it is about to rain.
5. **Save water, save our storm drain!** Watering grass less helps reduce water runoff. Avoid spraying sidewalks, driveways, and streets to prevent pollutants from being carried into storm drains.
