ber Expectations for WCU Recognized Student Organizations

By agreeing to join this organization, you agree to commit to a positive, professional, respectful, and inclusive environment. This document consists of examples of common member expectations that all members are required to adhere by:

1. Attendance and Punctuality:

Members are expected to attend required meetings and events on time. If there are specific attendance quotas, such as a set number of mandatory meetings, members must meet these requirements.

2. Respectful and Interpersonal Communication:

Members should conduct themselves professionally during meetings and events. This includes being respectful, open to feedback, and maintaining a positive attitude throughout.

3. Appropriate Language Use:

All members are required to use language that is considerate and appropriate. Harmful language—including swearing, slurs, insensitive remarks, bullying, and other forms of aggression—will not be tolerated.

4. Committee Participation:

If your organization has committees for members to participate in, these members who have committed to specific committees are expected to actively participate and contribute to the workgroup.

5. Time Management and Accountability:

Members engaged in projects or tasks must meet scheduled deadlines. If deadlines cannot be met, members should communicate in advance and explain any delays.

6. Respect for Organizational Structure:

While members are encouraged to ask questions and provide feedback on executive board decisions, this should be done in a respectful and constructive manner.

7. Confidentiality:

Members must respect the confidentiality of sensitive information shared during meetings or events. Personal or organizational information should not be shared inappropriately with others.

8. Commitment to Equity and Inclusion:

Members are expected to actively contribute to creating an inclusive and welcoming environment. Any actions that undermine this commitment may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the organization.

9. Executive Board members can add any other expectations related to the organization.
