Pathway Certificate

FOR COMMUNICATION STUDIES MAJORS AND MINORS

Any COM Major or COM Minor* interested in earning a community engagement pathway certificate can do so by taking only four courses (12 credits) from approved course options. Three of the four courses a student takes toward the community engagement pathway certificate (9 of the 12 credits) must be approved as general education courses. The three general education courses must have different prefixes.

| Course | Gen Ed | Pre-Req |
|---------|------------------|--|
| EDR 200 | Diversity | None |
| ENG 375 | Writing Emphasis | None |
| COM 385 | Writing Emphasis | COM 209 (or SPK 208), COM 211, COM 214 |
| COM 333 | None | COM 209 (or SPK 208), COM 211, and COM 215 |

COM Majors should follow the course sequence above.

*COM Minors could replace EDR 200 or ENG 375 with PSC 322 or PSC 356 if you want a class to count towards your speaking emphasis general education requirement.

*COM Minors who have had SUS 100 or SOC 100 or SOC 245 could replace EDR 200 or ENG 375 with SOC 309 if you want a class to count towards your speaking emphasis general education requirement.
