Pennsylvania Medical Assistance Resources

For Pennsylvania, each Medicaid (Medical Assistance) recipient is assigned a Behavioral Health Managed Care Organization based on the county of their residence. Most in-network services are located within the county of residence, with some overlap. For example, if you are a Chester County resident who is a Medicaid recipient your behavioral health benefits will most likely be through Community Care Behavioral Health Organization and most in network services will be within Chester County. The provider networks below will allow you to search for a provider based on your county of residence.
