As a multidisciplinary minor with a strong focus on <u>experiential learning</u> grounded in theory and research, it provides students with greater skills and knowledge in order to be <u>effective professionals in an urban environment</u>, and core courses and faculty who teach them take a <u>strength-based approach to urban youth</u>, families and communities. **This minor requires** *one extended format* **course** (YES 301), *that does not end until June*. **This minor is open to** *all majors*.
