Some requirements may not map in properly on the degree progress report. Students should meet with their academic advisor to discuss their degree progress.

5. **Repeating a Course--Important Information!** When you repeat a course, both enrollments will show in the DPR. Since credit can only be earned once, one enrollment will be removed when the repeated course has a final grade.

6. The **Download/Print Option (PDF)**: The last page of the PDF is a “Course History” page. It displays all courses you have taken in chronological order. This **does not** appear when viewing it in web format.
