

Honors College Advising

Important information for Honors students as they schedule each semester

Steps to Take

- 1. Find your major-related advisement sheet on the Honors Website: o https://www.wcupa.edu/deputy-provost/honorsCollege/advising.aspx
- 2. Schedule a meeting with your department-assigned advisor, found on your myWCU account
- 3. Bring your advisement sheet to your advising meeting explain how the sheet lists all the classes you are required to take
- 4. Look for your Honors College Schedule (generally sent in an email from Michelle) to see what Honors classes your Honors cohort is set to take this semester. Remember you can take Seminars during any semester!
- 5. If you are a Bridge Student, please consult Dr. Martin to ensure you are taking the classes you need

HONORS COLLEGE SEQUENCE BY SEMESTER



If you have any questions, reach out to your advisor!


