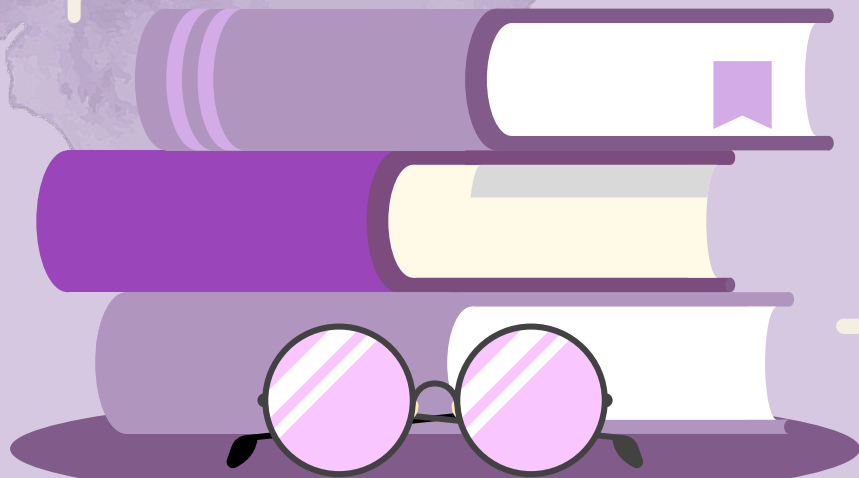




Honors College Advising

Honors students as they
schedule each semester

Steps to Take

- Find your major-related advisement sheet on the Honors Website:
 - <https://www.wcupa.edu/deputy-provost/honorsCollege/advising.aspx>
- Schedule a meeting with your department-assigned advisor, found on your myWCU account
 - Bring your advisement sheet to this meeting – explain how this sheet lists all the classes you are required to take
- Look for your Honors College Schedule (generally sent in an email from Michelle) to see what Honors classes your Honors cohort is set to take this semester. Remember you can take Seminars during a semester!
 - If you are a Bridge Student, please consult Dr. Martin to ensure you are taking the classes you need

Steps to find the Honors College Sequence by Semester

Go to wcupa.edu > Search Honors College > Click “Honors College – WCU of PA” > Scroll down to “Quick Links” and click on “Advising” > Click the second link labeled “Honors College Course Sequence”
