First Destination Survey Fall 2016: Graduate Program Students

During November and December of 2016, the Offices of Institutional Research and Graduate Studies of West Chester University of Pennsylvania (WCU) collaboratively conducted an online survey of students who were intending to graduate with a post baccalaureate degree at the end of the Fall 2016 term. Office of Institutional Research sent out email invitations to the prospective graduates. In addition, an opportunity to complete an online survey was provided to the graduates who personally collected cap & gown at the Office of Graduate Studies. The purpose of the survey was to assess their future plans. The survey consisted of the broad question: "What is your primary status after graduation?" as well as follow-up questions on their employment, volunteer work, military service, and continued education. Total of 114 students responded to the survey. This represents approximately 44.7% of the 255 students intending to graduate in August and December 2016. The findings of the survey are displayed below.

Primary Status / Primary Future Plans after Graduation:



Employment Status Regardless of Primary Future Plan:

Students graduating with a Master's degree were asked about their employment status regardless of their primary status/future plans after graduation. Total of 113 students reported about their employment status; of those, about 78.8% reported to be continuing in a current position, 5.3% have accepted a position, and 15.9% reported as not employed or haven't accepted a position.

Position Status Regardless of Primary Future Plan:

Regardless of their primary status/future plans after graduation, students who were employed or had accepted a position were asked about their position status. Of the students who responded to the survey and were employed or had accepted a position, about 83.2% reported to be in full-time paid employment and 16.8% in part-time paid employment.

Position Status by Employment Status Regardless of Primary Future Plan:

Regardless of their primary status/future plans after graduation, there were about 92.4% of the full-time employed and 100.0% of the part-time employed students continuing in a current position after graduation; 7.6% of the full-time employed students accepted a new position.

Position Status by Employment Type Regardless of Primary Future Plan:

Total of 95 students reported about their employment type. Regardless of their primary status/future plans after graduation, there were about 13.9% of the full-time employed and 37.5% of the part-time employed students working either as an entrepreneur, in a temporary/contract work assignment, as freelance, or in a post-graduate internship or fellowship; 86.1% of the full-time and 62.5% of the part-time employed students were working in all other work categories.

Position Status by Salary Range Regardless of Primary Future Plan:

The information about salary range was provided by 91 survey takers. The following table shows salary range distribution of full-time and part-time paid employment. Salaries of about 63.7% of the students with full-time paid employment were in the range of \$40,000 to \$69,999. Only 4 graduate students reported that they were guaranteed a first-year bonus. As per the received responses, the bonuses ranged from \$2,000 to \$10,000.

Regardless of their primary status/future plans after graduation, there were about 57.1% of students from the College of Art & Humanities, 32.1% students from the College of Business & Public Management, 79.5% of students from the College of Education & Social Work, 84.6% of students from the College of Health Sciences, and 44.4% of students from the College of Science & Mathematics who completed an internship at WCU.
