

Become a Social Work Field Instructor

Students are placed in Pennsylvania, Delaware, and New Jersey and can utilize their skills to assist in the following areas:

- Case Management
- Crisis Intervention
- Counseling
- Prevention/Education
- **Group Work**

- **BSW Juniors:** complete 244 hours during their spring semester (16 hours per week)
- **BSW Senior and MSW Generalist students:** complete 224 hours per semester (fall and spring) and must be supervised by someone with a BSW or MSW degree
- MSW Specialization students: complete 280 hours per semester (fall and spring) and must be supervised by someone with an MSW degree and two years experience (20 hours per week)

Field Instructors are invited to attend programmed events throughout the year with the opportunity to earn free CEU's. All events provide a great space to network with members of the WCU team and other Social Work professionals!
