#### **Special Notes:**

- All Respiratory Care Program Core Courses require a grade of a "C" or better.
- All General Education Requirements and Respiratory Care Program Pre-requisite Courses require a grade of a "C-" or better.
- All Respiratory Care Program Core Courses (HEA 370 through HEA 479) must be taken in the sequence and combination as listed on the Curriculum Guide.
- An overall GPA of 2.7 is required prior to the continuation to HEA 380—Clinical Practice I.
- If a student elects to complete both BIO 259 & BIO 269 at WCU, both must be taken at WCU. If the student elects to complete these at another college or university, both semesters must be transferred to WCU.
- Transferring credits from another college or university to meet the General Education Requirements or pre-requisites, due to a non-passing grade for the same course previously taken at WCU, is prohibited. In other words, any course that the student fails at WCU must be repeated at WCU.
- The honors list for commencement is based on the GPA from the next to last semester before graduation. Transfer students must have 60 hours of grades reported at WCU prior to that time to be recognized. Those students who do not attain honors distinction until the end of their final semester, or those who do not complete 60 hours until the end of the final semester, will have recognition of their achievement ONLY on their final transcripts, where all honors distinctions are recorded.

#### Pre-Requisites:

- BIO 259 is a pre-requisite for BIO 269.
- BIO 100 is a pre-requisite for BIO 204.
  - BIO 199 will NOT meet the pre-requisites for BIO 204 unless Biology Department approval is granted.
