

Windows 10 - An Overview

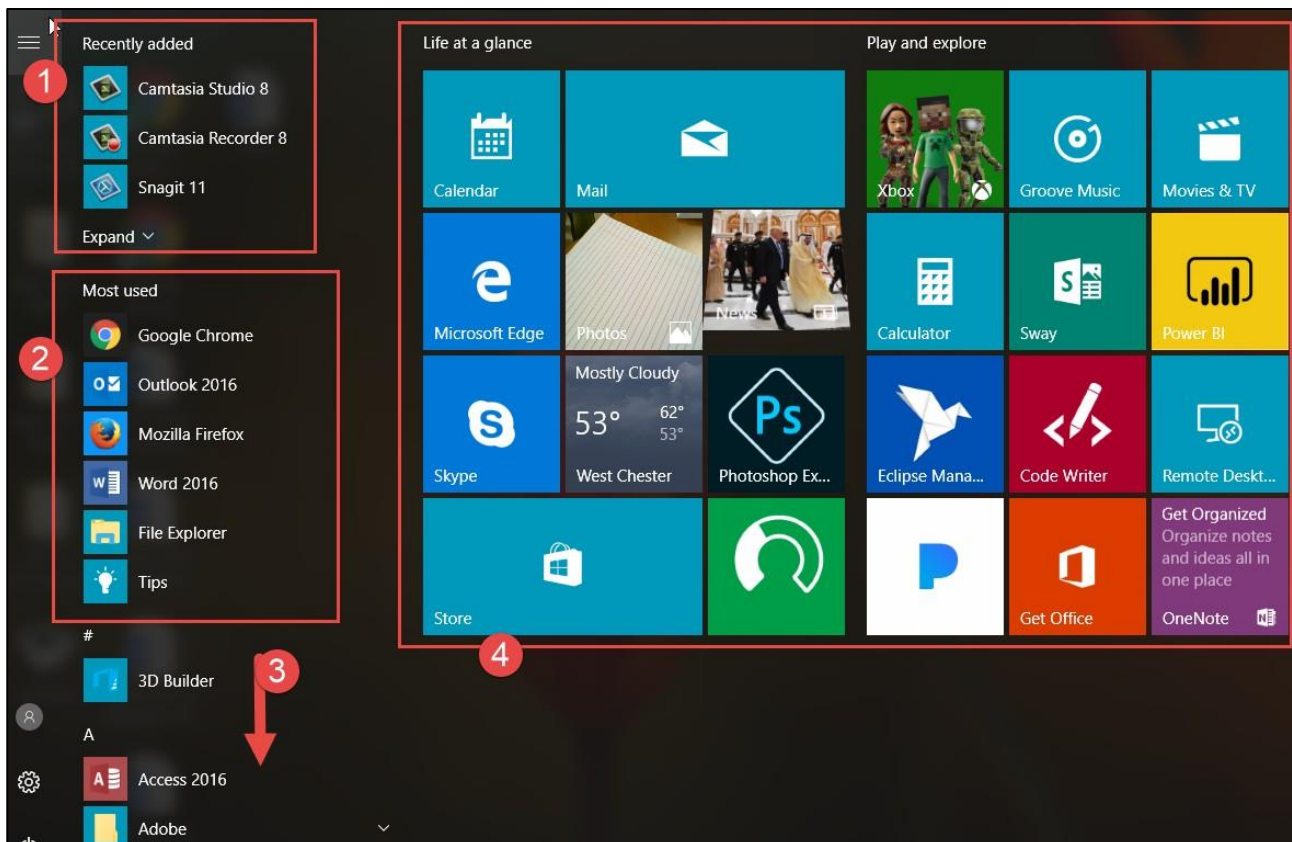
Windows 10:

The Start menu:

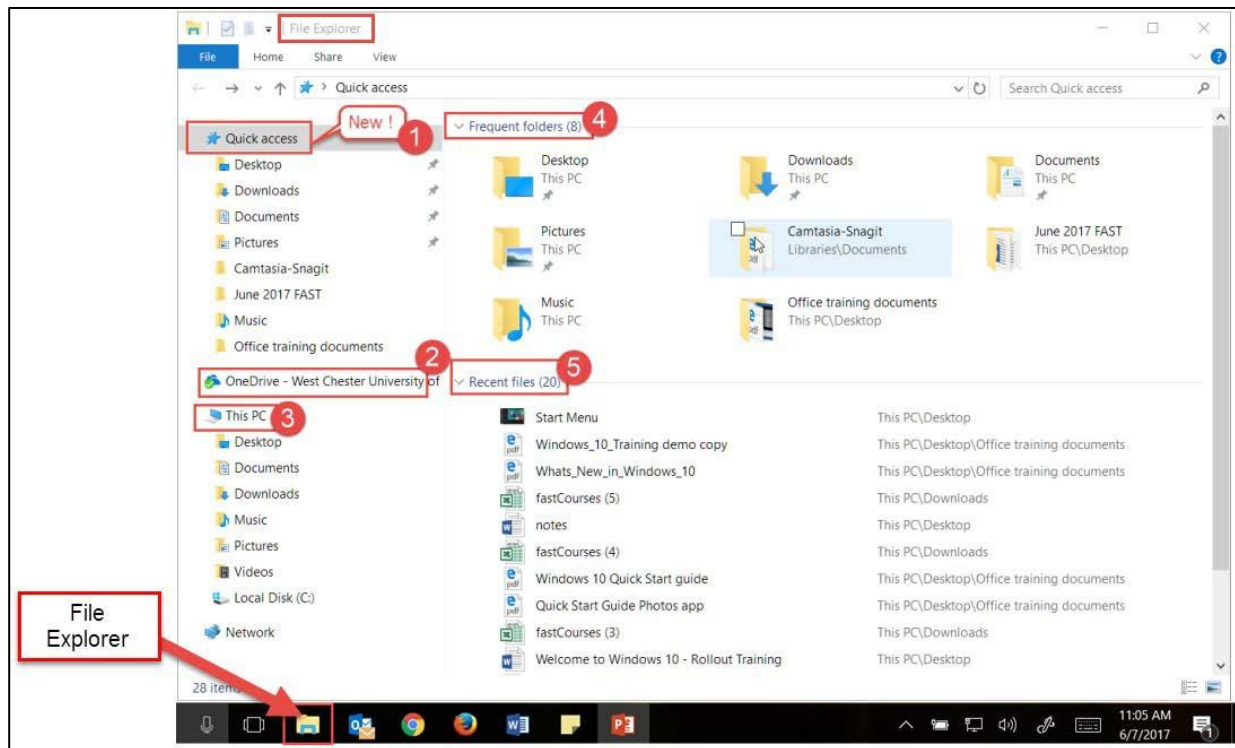
- 1.) Recently Added Apps

1. You can add/delete/resize/ categorize tiles as you wish

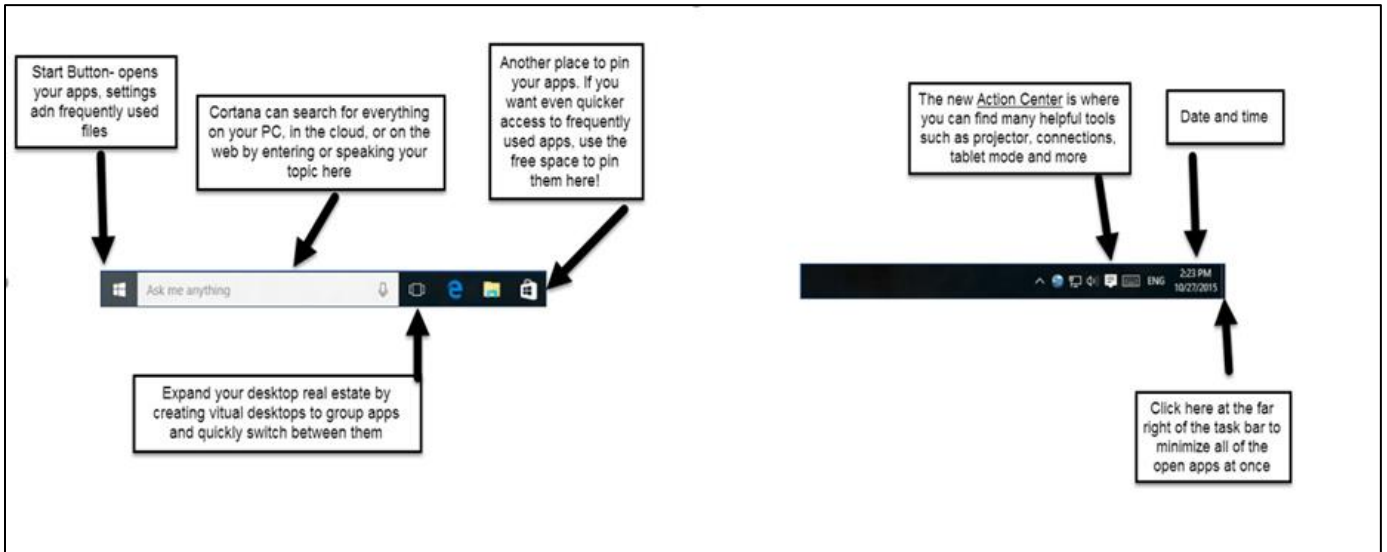


The New File Explorer:

5. Recent files

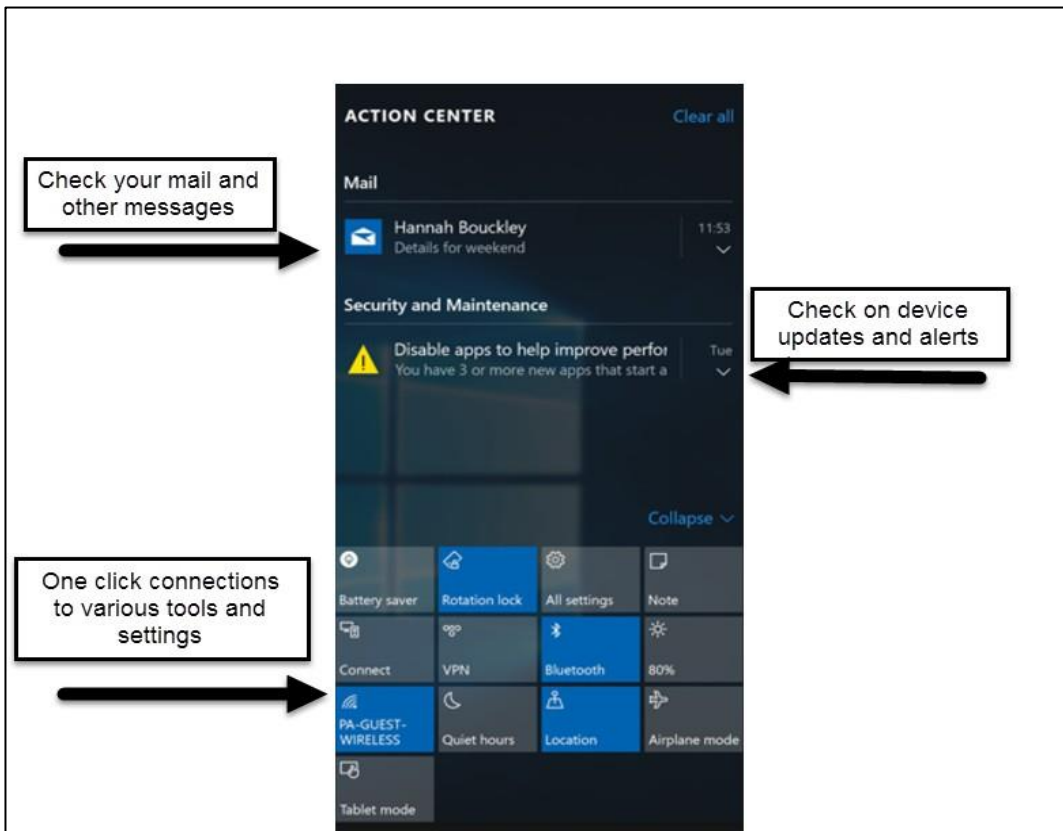


The Task Bar:



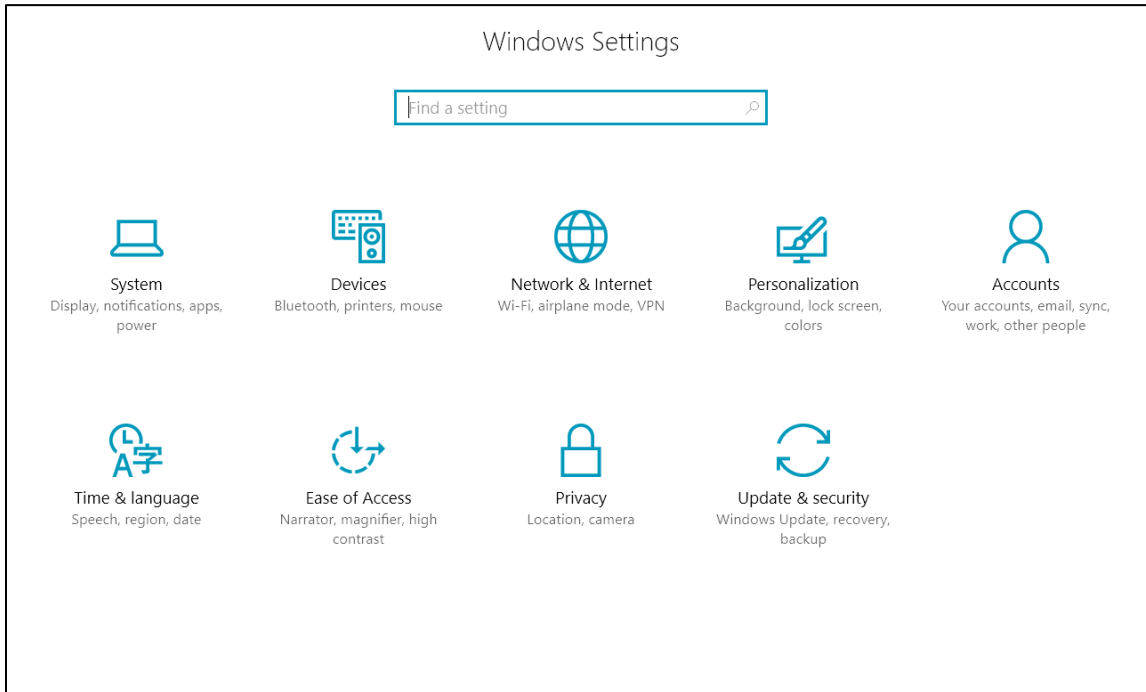
The Action Center:

Your shortcut to messages, alerts, tools and settings



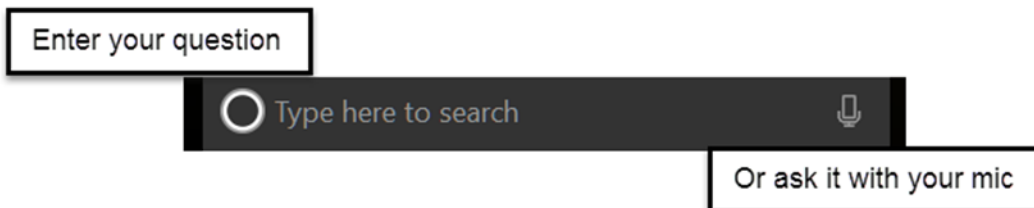
The Settings App:

This icon takes you to the Windows Settings App where you can do all of those tasks found in the old control panel.



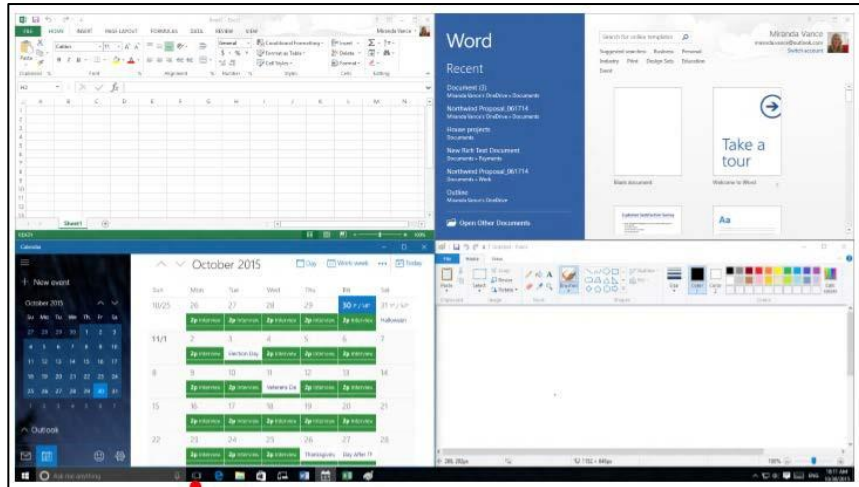
Cortana:
